Hog-Eye Fest Cook-Off Entry Rules & Regulations

Cook-Off: 1st Place - \$500

- All entries must be cooked on site.
- All contestants must follow standard food safety rules.
- All entries must use charcoal or wood. (No gas grills)
- You can enter as many categories as you wish.
- Final product must be submitted to the judges. Judges decision final.
- If using marinates for the cook-off, judges may ask for recipe.
- Each contestant may prepare more products to sell to the public on the day of contest.

Ice Cream Contest: 1st Place - \$250

- All contestants must follow standard food safety rules.
- You can enter as many categories as you wish.
- Final product must be submitted to the judges. Judges decision final.
- Entry must be hand cranked.
- No toppings of any kind on ice cream.
- Must submit ice cream recipe to the Hog Fest Committee.
- If entry has eggs in recipe, must be cooked at home before contest.
- Each contestant must provide one gallon to give to public, not including their entry.

The committee reserves the right to reject any application, if your application is not accepted, your money will be refunded. However, no refund of the application fee will be made once you have been accepted into the contest. Any photos taken of your team onsite and your responses to questions in the application become the property of Livingston-Overton County Merchant's Association and may be used for promotional purposes. Contestant agrees to indemnify and hold Livingston-Overton County Merchant's Association and its employees and volunteers, harmless from any and all claims made against the Hog-eye Fest Celebration, including, without limitation, all costs, liabilities, judgments, expenses, damages, or reasonable attorney fees, arising out of or in connection with (I) any structure erected by contestant, (II) an apparatus, equipment, or personal property used by contestant, (III) any act or omission to act of agents, and (IV) any claims made on account or resulting from contestants' participation in the contest.
